

The Cascade is hiring an arts writer!

An arts writer is responsible for writing two articles per issue for the Arts in Review and Culture & Events sections, at least one of which must be coverage, interview, or review of an arts event or figure at UFV, or in the local community (e.g. theatre, music, visual arts).

At all times, an arts writer must adhere to the policies and procedures of the Cascade Journalism Society and Canadian University Press Code of Ethics.

Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Attend writers' meetings and take assignments as needed.
2. Contribute a minimum of two full length articles per issue.
3. Must be able to write copy to deadline, complete copy in a timely manner, and be available to cover both on and off-campus events, as assigned by the Arts editor.
4. Perform other job-related duties as required by the Managing Editor and/or Editor-in-Chief.

Qualifications:

1. Must be registered in the equivalent of at least one (1) course for credit at UFV during the fall and winter semesters.
2. Must be available to work varying hours.
3. Must be able to deal effectively with Society and university staff, students, and the general public.
4. Must demonstrate strong command of the English language through writing ability.
