

## ***The Cascade* Illustrator**

Rate of pay: \$50 per issue

### **Job summary:**

The Illustrator is responsible for providing regular illustrated and graphic content for *The Cascade*, including but not limited to article illustrations, editorial cartoons, comics, and promotional materials as directed by the Production Manager. The Illustrator may also provide illustrative, graphic, or design support for the feature, cover, or specific sectional layouts as directed.

At all times, the Illustrator must adhere to The Cascade Journalism Society bylaws, Code of Conduct, and other policies; shall not violate the Canadian University Press Code of Ethics; and always behave in an ethical manner as a representative of the paper.

### **Duties and responsibilities:**

1. Provide at least four original illustrations or graphics per week.
2. Work in consultation with the Production Manager and other editorial staff to ensure illustrations and image content relates to written content and is appropriate for publication.
3. Provide illustrations or graphics for *Cascade* promotional materials as requested by the Production Manager.
4. In special circumstances, may assist with layout as requested by the Production Manager.

### **Qualifications**

1. Must be registered in at least one credit course for credit during the fall/winter semesters.
2. Must be available to work varying hours, especially on production days.
3. Must have advanced design skills, specifically with the Macintosh platform and Adobe Creative Suite software.
4. Must be a member in good standing of the Cascade Journalism Society.
5. Must be able to deal effectively with Society and university staff, students, and the general public.
